*Merit badge counselors **MUST** be registered as a Merit Badge Counselor with BSA-NCAC and be approved by the District Advancement Committee (Merit Badge Dean). Submit all forms **DIRECTLY** to the Merit Badge Dean (Adult Application, Merit Badge Counselor Information form and a copy of your Youth Protection Trained card).

*If you are registered with a unit as an adult leader, you still need to complete an additional Adult Application to be a Merit Badge Counselor.

*There is no registration fee to be a merit badge counselor.

*When completing your Adult Application use Position Code 42 and list Merit Badge Counselor as your position.
